## NEW 8:15 AM WORSHIP SERVICE

The Lord has been blessing us with increased attendance in all of our worship services and regular activities, especially since the beginning of the year. The first change to come because of the growth is in the schedule of services on Sunday. On May 27, we plan to begin a brand new early morning worship service at 8:15 AM to allow for even more growth.

That also means there will be some other changes to the schedule. Starting May 27, this is what the schedule will be:

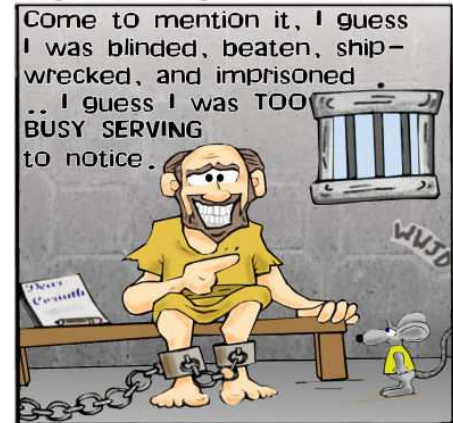

## FROM THE PULPIT

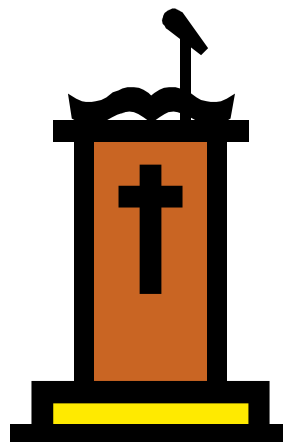
